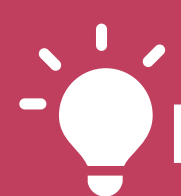




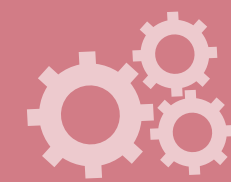
The first five years of life are when a child's brain grows the fastest.
